### CL HEALTH CAUTION X NOT DINNERWARE SAFE

The following Elements™ glazes bear a CL (Health Caution) label and should not be used by children under 12. Though they meet the FDA standards for Food Safe, they are not recommended for dinnerware as as the fired finish is not chemically durable and can be impacted by contact with liquid or food. Additionally, if your ware exhibits textured surface issues such as cracks or crazing, attempts to adequately clean the surface may cause the underlying low-fire porous ware to absorb water and fail. Recommended for ornamental use only.

\*The above chart is recommended usage for low fire (earthenware cone 05/06) dinnerware. Elements™ with surface texture applied to vitrified clay bodies at mid-range or high-fire temperatures do not have the same concern and may be considered dinnerware safe. Finishedware producers may be required to have their ware food safe tested prior to introducing into commerce.
